Under her leadership, Centre *Venture* emerged as one of Canada’s leading redevelopment organizations, successfully encouraging a wide range of municipal/business partnerships, which resulted in significant private investment downtown.

Her commitment to the community is both professional and personal. An active supporter of the volunteer sector, she co-chaired the community campaign for the new Millennium Library, served on the United Way Campaign for three years and Winnipeg Poverty Reduction Council for four years and is currently a member of the board with St. Amant Inc.
